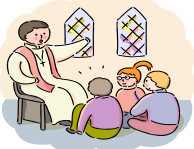

Dear Friend of Island Harvest,

During the summer months, Island Harvest member agencies are in even greater need of donated food because kids are out of school and their families need additional resources. To meet this need Island Harvest has once again organized our annual Summer Food Blitz.

On select days in July and August, we rally hundreds of volunteers, food companies, and member feeding programs to meet in central locations and transfer about 500,000 pounds of food. The feeding programs take this food to their facilities, where those who need it can get it.

Volunteers are needed to assist with setting up and sign-in, unloading supply trucks, and packing and loading agency vehicles. Events will have two shifts between 8am - 3:30pm. *Some positions require lifting.*
